Excellent event from Daniel Bracken-Neale in the Slice of India, we should support future social activities Also, presented at the Derbyshire ECT sessions, as usual we were the only Union there.

Strike Map UK

At their meeting in July, the Executive noted the excellent work of <u>Strike Map UK</u> in sharing information and building solidarity across the union movement for workers taking industrial action. The Executive agreed a donation to Strike Map and to encourage NEU Districts to affiliate too - individuals can also register as supporters of Strike Map UK for a small monthly donation.

Attended the in-person Sexual Harassment toolkit launch.

DBN included information around the letter surrounding the letter to Education Secretary explaining that the NEU will ballot for strike action. It's crucial for members to ensure their postal addresses are up to date. The intent will be to coordinate with other Unions to have maximum impact, and we must oppose the narrative demonising Union activity. The pay increase must be fully funded.

There was a general discussion based on the ballot turnout activity.

4) Treasurer's Report – DBN presented his report and discussed member engagement activities, recruitment, and campaign promotion. DBN reiterated that we are the only Union who attend many activities, and that we should purchase merch to support recruitment events. RPR suggested that porcelain and bamboo mugs are a great talking point. Also that the highlighters and pens always go down well. PB proposed the accounts, RPR seconded. All in favour. DBN proposed to use small business accountants.

- 2) DBN explained that the office in Matlock was condemned, and Derbyshire have found a new block on the same site at the same rent. Useful for merch storage and discreet member meetings.
- 3) Guest speakers Daniel Kebede and Niamh Sweeney each gave a talk to support their campaigns to become the next NEU General Secretary. The meeting moved to vote for the General Secretary at the next meeting after having time to reflect on the presentations given.
- 4) Representation at Conferences Member representation at the LGBTQ+ Conference, CB invited them to come speak about it at a future meeting. CB to reach out to members who attend conferences to provide a written report where necessary. All events and conferences are available to view on the NEU Derbyshire website. DBN has booked the hotel ready for Harrogate conference 2023.
- 5) Equality Issues. DBN explained that menopause policies are being adopted by some academies, and that Derbyshire Local Authority are working on one. Period absence should be a consideration for removal from absence records also. DBN to draft an equality-based motion to propose to conference around the punitive nature of absence policies for issues relating to protected characteristics.

Model Motion for NEU Districts

Cuba Education Appeal

This District notes that:

- 2022 marks the 60th anniversary of the US blockade of Cuba despite 29 UN General Assembly votes calling for its termination. The blockade causes shortages across all sectors in Cuba, including education.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic the blockade added to the suffering and loss of life on the island by preventing purchase and delivery of vital equipment and medicines to treat patients and the roll out Cuba's vaccination programme.
- Despite the blockade, Cuba with some of the best education indicators in Latin America has, in the
 year 2000, met all the objectives set by the UNESCO supported Education for All (EFA). Cuban
 students and teachers however are frequently forced to make do without many of the basic
 necessities that we take for granted.
- In 2021, Oxfam reported that, during the pandemic, the US blockade slowed the use of new technologies for teaching and forced Cuba to resort to broadcasting daily classes to 1.7 million students on television.
