CB delivered a verbal report highlighting the following issues. A discussion was held as a part of the conversation.

The National picture – Industrial Action, encouraging pickets, attending rallies, and visibility, keeping public opinion of union activity positive.

The Regional picture – Workplace Rep Density and Building Union Structures in Settings, particularly focusing on primary settings.

The Local picture – Casework, Building local confidence, encouraging attendance, social events, facilities time and the growth of MATs, retention.

CB also recommended the new Education Support Partnership report, teaching – the new reality.

4) Treasurer's Report

DBN delivered his written report and discussed hardship payments. DBN requested additional signatories volunteer to authorise payments. RB and PS volunteered to help with this.

DBN proposed an increase by 20% by £18k, GW seconded. All in favour. DBN proposed to cancel the ordered NEU beanies and to order new stock from Pellacraft. RB suggested a hoodie based on the experience at conference, and a loyalty card system mentioned. DBN proposed that we spend up to £5000 on new merchandise. RPR seconded. All in favour. Classroom thermometers was also discussed.

5) Equalities Officer Introduction & Report

AT introduced herself and spoke to the group about looking forward to attending the Equalities Conference and will report back on return. She then gave a short talk about her experiences and how these have informed her role. AT also offered to be a central point of conversation around equalities for the district and for members to connect and gain support and guidance. CB to investigate whether NEU email addresses are available for district officer roles other than rep and treasurer.

- 2) **Conference Discussion** RPR led a talk about the purpose of conference. Some of the delegates shared their anecdotal experiences of the 2023 conference, and encouraged anyone who hasn't yet been to go.
- 3) International Solidarity RPR introduced internationalism. SW talked about her wanting to be as part of the NEU Cuba Delegation, with a particular focus on inclusion. RPP spoke about the Cuba Solidarity Campaign. SW proposed. RB seconded and all voted in favour of supporting SW.
- 4) Industrial Action update RPR stated the NEU ballot will open 15th May. NASUWT ballot 5th June to 10th July. Leadership support the idea of strike action but this may not be translating to sister union ballots. A discussion was held around attitudes and opinions towards the strike action from different places in the profession. The group also discussed the hardship fund and summer action.
- 5) Issues in Schools Behaviour is a huge issue across schools. Stress around behaviour and antisocial behaviour. DBN suggested asking schools what will be done with the money saved by colleagues taking strike action. GW spoke about claiming back bank holiday time in lieu.
